Commissioners Hinshaw & Turrentine attended KTB training in Tyler on Dec. 4th, satisfying the training requirement for reinstatement. Once dues are paid, Parker will be reinstated as active members.

Commissioners shared information from their program, called Keep Tyler Beautiful. Many resources, grants, and training available through membership.

4. CONSIDERATION AND/OR ANY APPROPRIATE ACTION/DISCUSSION OF WILDFLOWERS. [Ware]

Ms. Burgess had conversation with city of Allen. Need master plan for many grant applications. Raised question of developers paying fees that go towards parks.

Park is Whitestone will be turned over from developer to HOA. Trail will connect with Chapparal in Allen. Park will have gazebo. Trail will turn east to a future greenbelt at creek (along Dillehay).

According to Chair Barron's research, preserve sold as a native habitat but under no obligation to restrict to native species. Would want to stick to the spirit of agreement. Pier – "native" is a gray area.

Chair Barron has copy of Collin County open parks strategic plan. Mayor Pettie is not aware of any master plan. Collin plan pre-dates Parker plan. City of Parker trail plan goes through multiple houses in Parker Ranch. Developers are required to follow the county plan.

Commissioner Hinshaw suggested hosting a holiday event in future. (similar to Hallmark Townhall Holiday). Hinshaw moved to hang lights around City Hall. Hinshaw seconded, Ware, Barron, Slaughter voting for. Motion carried 5-0. Mayor Pettie will send out note to council members. Mr. Machado will look at bringing electricity to area for tree lighting.

Spring event could combine a KTB clean-up along with other activities, such as fun run, food trucks, t-shirts, etc. Per Mayor Pettie, bring plan to council along advance notice of expenditures.

Mr. Machado provided update on preserve maintenance: trees trimmed, broken plexiglass removed at sign, refilled pond, etc. More work to come – working off checklist. Pond is not natural, doesn't hold water and must be refilled from creek.
