NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE SEWER
UTILITY SERVICE IN COLLIN COUNTY

City of Parker has filed an application to obtain a sewer CCN with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide sewer utility service in Collin County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 5 miles east of downtown Plano, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Lucas Road; on the east by Stinson Road; on the south by Curtis Lane; and on the west by FM 2551 (Dillehay Road). The total area being requested includes approximately 766 acres and 278 current customers.

A copy of the proposed service area map is available at the City of Parker, 5700 E. Parker Road, Parker, Texas 75002 and Phone Number 972/442-6811.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "Uwe request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

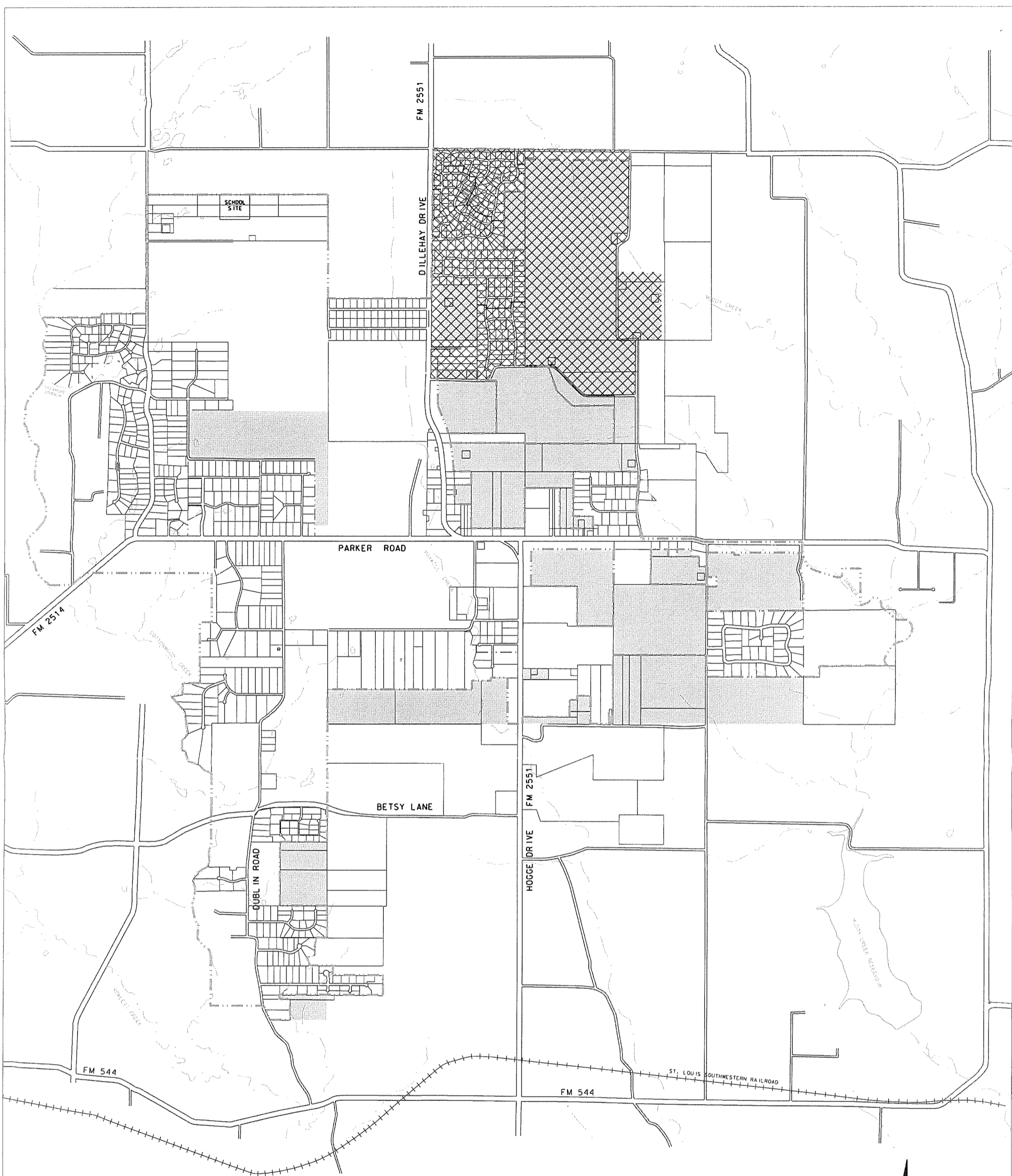

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.







If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAR) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAR will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

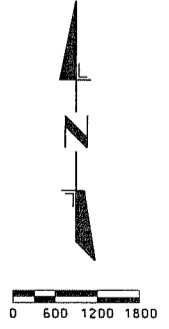
