CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 27, 2023

CALL TO ORDER – Roll Call and Determination of a Quorum

The Parker City Council met in a special meeting on the above date at Parker City Hall, 5700 E. Parker Road, Parker, Texas, 75002.

Mayor Lee Pettle called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Councilmembers Terry Lynch, Amanda Noe and Jim Reed were present. Mayor Pro Tem Michael Slaughter and Councilmember Todd Fecht were absent.
