



Animal Trap Regulations

Do not set traps if any of the following exist:

- Freezing
- Raining
- Extreme heat / cold

On warm days, please place the trap in the shade and on cool days cover the trap with towel. When baiting the trap, please place both food and a small water container inside the cage.

To avoid possible citations, do not allow any of the listed infractions (*not a citable offense), to occur:

<input type="checkbox"/> Trap is not being checked (at least once) daily	
<input type="checkbox"/> *Trap is not within normal reach from ground level other:	

TRAPS MUST BE CHECKED EACH MORNING AND CALLED IN TO CITY HALL BY 10 AM.

Trapping is not allowed Thursday night through Saturday night or City observed Holidays.

If you have any other animal control issues between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, please call City Hall at (972) 442-6811, and an animal control officer will respond to your needs.

If it is an animal emergency after 4:30 p.m. or on weekends, call Dispatch at (972) 468-4236 so a Parker Police Officer can respond.
